WINDSOR MACHINE GROUP SELECTS GIBSON COUNTY, INDANA

Princeton, IN (December 4, 2009) – Windsor Machine Group, makers of automotive headrests, seating components, exhaust suspension systems, modular assemblies, rubber and plastic products and structural brackets and braces; headquartered in Windsor, Ontario has selected Princeton, Indiana in Gibson County to locate their next manufacturing plant according to Dave Zultek, CFO of The Windsor Group.

“We have made the commitment to Gibson County and we are moving forward outfitting the building we are leasing from Gibson County Warehousing, Incorporated. Also we have started the process of filling teammember positions as we anticipate starting production just after the first of the new year.” said Zultek.

Windsor Machine Group anticipates hiring forty (40) people to open their operation with future growth at the Gibson County plant expected to top out at 130 people.

B. Todd Mosby, President and CEO of the Gibson County Economic Development Corporation stated the news will be welcomed by residents in the tri-state. He said, “Securing Windsor Machine Group was a team effort as the opportunity came to Gibson County through the Indiana Economic Development Corporation.” Mosby said, “Assistance in the effort also came from the Economic Development Coalition of Southwest Indiana. This was a team effort; from the state, to the region, to the local economic development organization and the local governing body.” On Tuesday, November 10th The Gibson County Council approved a resolution to provide personal property tax phase-in at the request of Mosby. Zultek collaborated that Windsor’s search included multiple sites in Indiana, Kentucky, Tennessee and even Mexico. However, it was the effort by the local officials that made a difference in this selection.

Windsor Machine Group will be producing headrests products for Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Indiana as well as other products for GM and Ford from their Gibson County Plant.
