WNIN next on list for completed Regional Cities Projects



WNIN, the Tri-State's public broadcasting station located in Evansville, Indiana, celebrated its move to Main Street with an open house commemorating the third project to be closed-out for the Regional Cities Initiative. The WNIN project received \$500,000 in Regional Cities specifically to build the new radio and television studios, as well as the public theater.

To date, the Southwest Indiana Regional Development Authority (SWIRDA) has received approval for 12 projects representing \$38M in Regional Cities funding, totaling over \$587M in total investment for the region.

The media resources and increased offerings with the move to Main Street will allow WNIN to continue to be a leader for the Region and build the brand of Southwest Indiana through the power of public media.
