Regional Cities project Friedman Park Event Center to help expand Regional Brand

NEWBURGH, IN (April 2, 2019) The State of Indiana announced today the approval of a Regional Cities project in Warrick County that will expand the list of the community's amenities as well as increase exposure for the community and regional brand of Indiana's Great Southwest. The Friedman Park Event Center, an approximately 16,000 square foot multi-use facility, will be built within the 140 acres of Friedman Park in Newburgh, Indiana adjacent to Victoria National Golf Club, one of the nation's top courses and home to the Web.com Tour Championship presented by United Leasing & Finance.

The Event Center's primary purpose will be to host events, conferences and corporate events as well as community and business functions; and, help to promote the area as a desirable destination for residents and visitors. The Friedman Park Event Center is a \$4.7 million dollar project, and when combined with the construction of Friedman Park, it is an \$11.6 million dollar transformative regional destination. The Friedman Park Event Center was awarded \$2 million in state funding through Indiana's Regional Cities Initiative, which encourages communities across the state to work together to transform their regions into nationally-recognized destinations for talent.
